

IPA Announces Annual Competition Between Chapters to Promote Aviation Safety

All IPA members are eligible.

Each year, the competition will begin on the day of the IPA Annual Meeting, and will end on the day before the next IPA Annual Meeting.

The winning pilot will be the one who accumulates the most points. The winning chapter will be determined by adding the points earned by its members and dividing by the number of members of the chapter.

The first year will end before the IPA Annual Meeting in year 2012. Winning chapter and pilot will be recognized at the annual IPA meeting.
